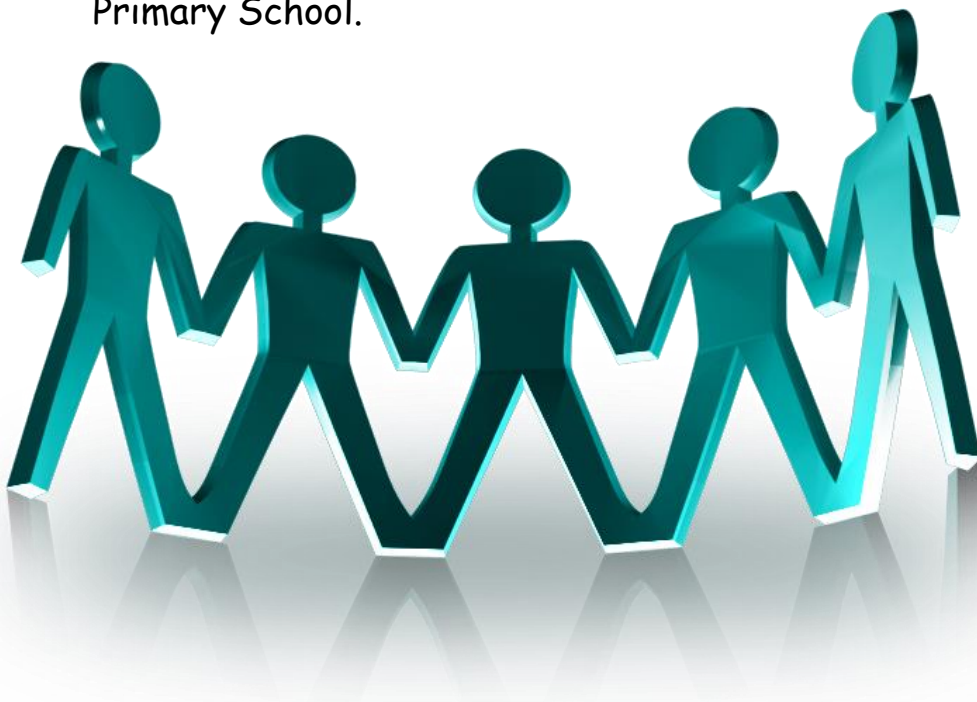
The aim of the evening is for a representative from all our community groups and committees to participate in an open forum. Each group will be given 5 minutes to talk about their activities and their aims for the future.
