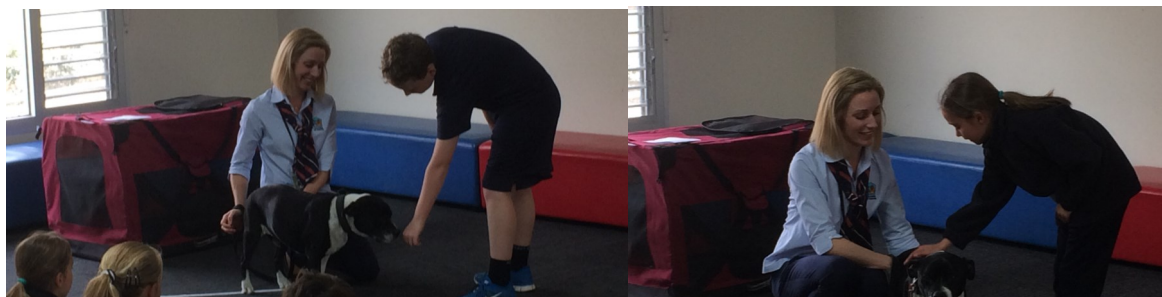

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## **IMMUNISATION CERTIFICATES**

We have been notified by the Department that there has been an outbreak of measles in the northern suburbs of Melbourne. Measles usually begins with common cold symptoms such as fever, sore throat, red eyes and a cough. A rash usually begins 3-7 days after the first symptoms, generally starting on the face and then spreading to the rest of the body. When outbreaks such as these occur it is really important that the school have records of children's immunisation certificates. **If you have not supplied your child's to the school a request will be sent home today. Please send in the certificate as soon as possible.**

## **KINDER VISITS**

As you may know, we work with the kindergarten throughout the year to ensure a smooth transition to our school. However, our more formal transition to school visits began on Wednesday with the kinder children collecting our Prep/1 class on their way back from the Library Van. They then returned to kinder together. This was a great session and I know our Prep/1 class is very excited about their next visit to our school.
