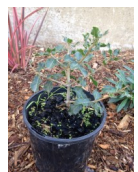


2016 PREPS

HEAD LICE**I guess it is the way you look at a problem...**

In some cultures **not** to have head lice is the problem. There is an old Bedouin proverb, referring to head lice, that equates ' **a deserted head with an ungenerous mind**'!!

There have been cases of head lice reported within the school again. Head lice can be controlled but it takes a systematic approach – follow these steps and remember if you **look** once a week using this conditioner and comb method you find a molehill before it's a mountain

Step 1

Comb inexpensive hair conditioner on to dry, brushed (detangled) hair. This makes it difficult for lice to grip the hair or run around;

Step 2

Wipe the conditioner from the comb onto a paper towel or tissue;

Step 3

Look on the tissue and on the comb for lice and eggs;

Step 4

If lice or eggs are found, the child should be treated;

Step 5

If the child has been treated recently and only hatched eggs are found, you may not have to treat since the eggs could be from the old infection.

There is no need to make a huge effort to clean the entire house. Only the pillowcase requires specific laundering. It is important that we share the accurate information about head lice. There are families at Katandra West that may be having similar problems to you.
